

THROUGH THEIR EYES

In 1996 the Strom Thurmond Institute, the History Department and the Clemson Communication Center initiated a project to document, through video taped oral histories, the development of Clemson University. Entitled **THROUGH THEIR EYES**, the project team talks about critical points in Clemson history with the people who participated in those events. Among completed interviews are: Dr. Walter Cox, Dr. Robert Edwards, Dr. Ernest Lander, Dr. Hugh Macaulay, Dr. Harlan McClure, Dr. Wallace Trevillian, Dr. Kenneth Vickery, and Mr. Joe Young, Mr. Jimmy Howard (with comments regarding his father), Mr. Carl McHugh, and Dr. Linvil Rich.

The idea for the project was developed by Clinton H. Whitehurst, Jr., professor emeritus and Senior Fellow of the Strom Thurmond Institute. Dr. Donald McKale of Clemson's History faculty has conducted all of the interviews except for Dr. Robert C. Edward's interview. Dr. Stephen Wainscott from the Honors College interviewed Dr. Edwards.

The resulting tapes have documented Clemson's history through stories and insights only known by the people who participated in those events. It is our hope to continue further development of the "**Through Their Eyes**" project by sharing with the Clemson family these oral histories.
